Beach Happy



Stamps: Beach Happy (retiring) **Ink:** Tuxedo Black Momento
Cardstock: Whisper White, Basic Black, Sahara Sand, So Saffron, Gingham Gala 6" x 6" Designer (retiring)

Accessories: SNAIL, Stampin' Dimensionals, Paper Snips, Whisper White Medium Envelopes, Celebrate You Thinlits (retiring), Liquid Glue

Measurements:

Sahara Sand card base: 4 1/4" x 11", scored at 2 3/4" and 5 1/2" **Easel layer:** 4" x 5 1/4"

Daffodil Delight Gingham Gala Designer: 3 3/4" x 5", 4" x 5 1/4" **for envelope flap:** 2 1/4" x 5 3/4"

Lemon Lime Twist Gingham Gala Designer for umbrella: 1 1/4" x 3"

Basic Black and So Saffron for "celebrate" and "YOU": 1 1/2" x 4" and 1 1/2" x 2" – two each

Whisper White inside: 3" x 3" **Basic Black inside:** 3 1/4" x 3 1/4"

Stamping tips:

Stamp trees and beach chair on 3 3/4" x 5" DSP layer with black ink. Adhere layer to 4" x 5 1/4" Sahara Sand layer with SNAIL. Adhere layer to 2 3/4" x 4 1/4" end of Sahara Sand card base with SNAIL.

Stamp umbrella on Lemon Lime Twist scrap with black ink. Cut out with Paper Snips. Adhere over the umbrella stamped on the Daffodil Delight front layer with dimensionals.



Cut out “celebrate” and “YOU” from both Basic Black and So Saffron. Adhere one on top of the other with Liquid Glue, leaving a shadow of one color showing behind the top one. Adhere to card front with Liquid Glue.



Stamp inside white layer with black ink. Adhere to black layer with SNAIL. Adhere inside card with SNAIL.

Adhere the “YOU” pieces together with liquid glue. Adhere inside card to create the easel “stop” with thinly cut strips of dimensionals.



To add DSP to the outside of the envelope flap, add a line of SNAIL all around the edges of the flap. Adhere the DSP piece to the flap, lining up the edge of the piece with the top fold of the flap. Press the DSP securely all around the edges, then trim the DSP to match the shape of the flap with scissors.

Stamp envelope to match card if desired.
