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Silhouette Scenes Umbrella Couple



Stamps: Silhouette Scenes, Darling Label Punch Box **Ink:** Tuxedo Black Memento, Versamark

Cardstock: Whisper White, Basic Black, See A Silhouette Designer, Blueberry Bushel, Silver Foil

Accessories: SNAIL, Paper Snips, Medium Whisper White Envelopes, Sweet Silhouette Dies, Liquid Glue, Embossing Buddy, Black Shimmer Embossing Powder, Heat Tool

Measurements:

Basic Black card base: 4 ¼" x 11", scored and folded at 5 ½"

See A Silhouette Designer for card front: 4" x 5 ¼" **for envelope flap:** 2 ¼" x 5 ¾"

Basic Black to cut out tree: 4" x 5 ¼"

Whisper White inside: 3 ½" x 4 ¾" **Blueberry Bushel mat behind inside white layer:** 3 5/8" x 4 7/8" **Silver Foil to cut out "forever":** 2" x 5 ½"

Stamping tips:

Adhere See A Silhouette Designer paper to card front with SNAIL.

Rub card front with Embossing Buddy. Stamp umbrella couple with Versamark. Sprinkle with Shimmer Black embossing powder. Heat with Heat Tool.



Cut Silver Foil with Sweet Silhouette Die with cutting edge of die facing up and the paper laying on top. Adhere to card front with tiny dots of liquid glue.



Stamp inside white layer with sentiments from Silhouette Scenes and Darling Label Punch Box using black ink. Adhere to Blueberry Bushel layer with SNAIL. Adhere inside card with SNAIL

Cut Basic Black using the tree die with the card stock laying on top of the cutting edges facing up. Roll die back and forth through the die cutting machine a couple of times. Lay die with card stock still in it on die brush foam mat. Roll die brush over the flat metal side of the die to loosen the tree from the card stock. Gently pull the tree free from the card stock around it one branch at a time. Snip off a couple of branches with Paper Snips. Adhere branches inside card with tiny dots of liquid glue on each branch tip and long the branch itself. There's no need to put glue on every leaf; just the tips and branches is enough.



To add DSP to the outside of the envelope flap, add a line of SNAIL all around the edges of the flap. Adhere the DSP piece to the flap, lining up the edge of the piece with the top fold of the flap. Press the DSP securely all around the edges, then trim the DSP to match the shape of the flap with scissors. Stamp front of envelope to match card if desired.
