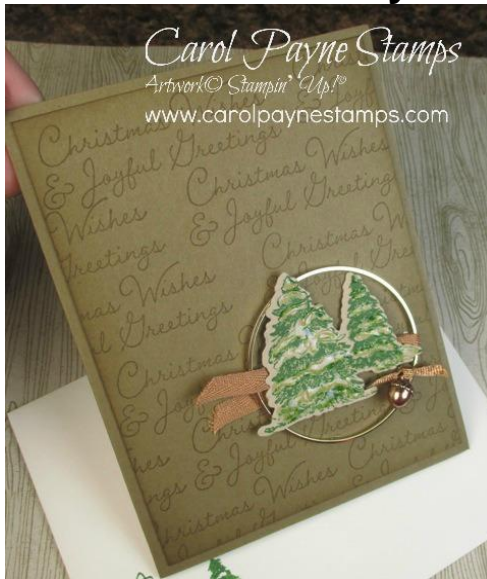

## Snow Wonder Snowy Pines



**Stamps:** Snow Wonder **Ink:** Soft Suede, Garden Green **Cardstock:** Soft Suede, Crumb Cake  
**Accessories:** Stampin' Seal, Medium Very Vanilla Envelopes, Shimmery Crystal Effects, Cinnamon Cider ¼" In Color Ribbon, Basket Weave & Metallic Ribbon Combo Pack, Gold Hoops Embellishments, Mini Glue Dots, Snow Time Dies, Stamping Sponges, Acorn Trinkets

### Measurements:

**Soft Suede card base:** 8 ½" x 5 ½" scored at 4 ¼" **front layer:** 4" x 5 ¼"

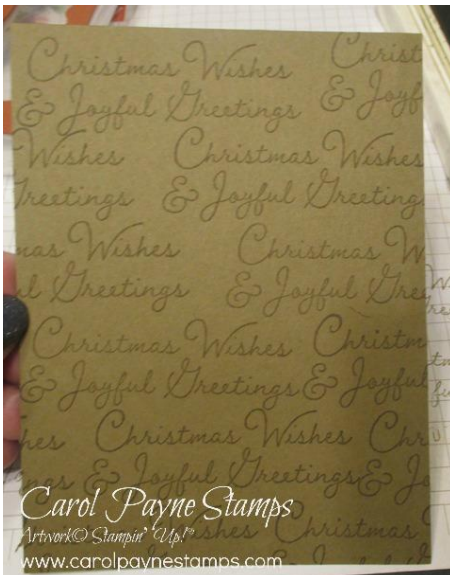
**Crumb Cake for pine trees:** 2 ½" x 2 ¼" **inside layer:** 3 ½" x 4 ¾"

**Garden Green inside mat:** 3 5/8" x 4 7/8"

**Metallic Copper ribbon:** about 3" **Cinnamon Cider ribbon:** about 6"

### Stamping directions:

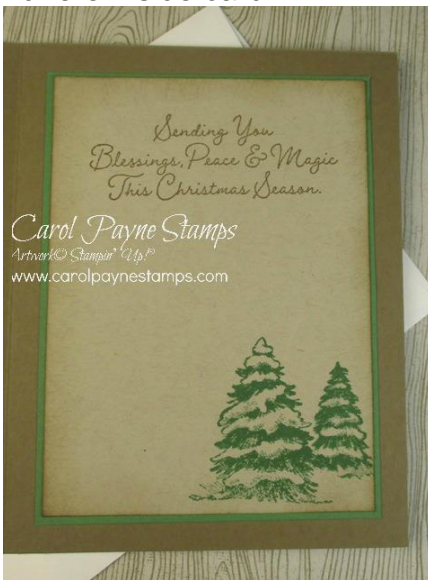
Stamp background sentiment across Soft Suede front layer with Soft Suede ink. Sponge edges with Soft Suede ink. Adhere to card front.



Stamp pines on Crumb Cake with Garden Green ink. Cut with Snow Time die. Wrap ribbon around right side of Gold Hoop. Secure with glue dots, splaying the ends apart slightly. Trim ends of ribbon with scissors. Adhere to lower right card front with glue dots. Adhere the pines over the ribbon with mini dimensionals. Thread copper metallic ribbon through the loop at the top of the Acorn Trinket, tying in a knot. Trim ends with scissors. Adhere inside hoop below the pines with a glue dot. Add Shimmery Crystal Effects to the "snow" areas of the pines. Allow to dry for at least 10 minutes before touching.



Stamp inside Crumb Cake layer with sentiment using Soft Suede ink. Stamp pines in lower right corner with Garden Green ink. Sponge edges with Soft Suede ink. Adhere to Garden Green layer. Adhere inside card.



Stamp the front and flap of the envelope as desired to match the card.
