


# Carol Payne, Independent Stampin' Up! Demonstrator

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## Tasteful Touches Triple Time



**Stamps:** Tasteful Touches, Lovely You      **Ink:** Night of Navy, Gray Granite

**Cardstock:** Night of Navy, Whisper White      **Accessories:** Stampin' Seal adhesive, Mini Stampin' Dimensionals, Glue Dots, Medium Whisper White Envelopes, Flowers For Every Season Ribbon Combo Pack, 2020/2022 In Color Enamel Dots

### Measurements:

**Night of Navy card base:** 5 ½" x 8 12", scored and folded at 4 ¼"

**Night of Navy Triple Time mat layers:** 2 ¼" x 3 ½",      3 ¼" x 4 ½"

**Whisper White Triple Time layers to stamp:** 2" x 3 ¼", 3" x 4 ¼", 4" x 5 ¼"      **greeting:** 2" x 3"

**Whisper White inside layer:** 4" x 5 ¼"      **twine:** about 6 inches

### Stamping tips:

Adhere all three white triple time layers to stamp together with a little bit of adhesive. Enough to keep them from moving while stamping but not so much the layers will rip when taken apart.

Stamp the feather randomly over all the layers with stamped-off Night of Navy ink. Stamp the little squares randomly between the feathers with Gray Granite ink. You will want to press the stamp heavily and evenly all over to make sure the image makes contact where the layers overlap each other. Gently take the layers apart to add to the corresponding Night of Navy card base and mat layers with adhesive.



After adhering the largest stamped layer to the card front with SNAIL, adhere the middle layers with SNAIL. Adhere to top layers with a dimensional in each corner. You will want to match the feathers to each other. NOTE: Even though the Night of Navy mat layers are in between the parts of the image, you eye will "see" the feather as continuous.



Stamp greeting on white with Night of Navy ink. Cut out with largest circle from the Tasteful Labels dies. Add Night of Navy ink to half of circle and Gray Granite to the other half using Spong Daubers. Tie about 6 inches of the Flowers for Every Season twine around the center of the circle (between "ARE" and "THE") tying in a knot on the right side. Secure the knot with a rolled-up glue dot as you are tying it to help keep from tying too tight or too loose. Adhere to card with mini stampin' dimensionals. Add a Misty Moonlight In Color Enamel Dot using a Take Your Pick tool.



Stamp sentiment on white inside layer with Night of Navy ink. Add a couple of feathers with stamped-off Night of Navy ink. Add a couple of squares with Gray Granite ink. Sponge half of layer edge with Night of Navy ink and the other half with gray Granite. Adhere inside card.



Stamp front and flap of envelope to match card.
