

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Timeless Tulips



Stamps: Timeless Tulips **Ink:** Flirty Flamingo, Pear Pizzazz, Tuxedo Black **Cardstock:** Flirty Flamingo, Whisper White, Pear Pizzazz, Pleased As Punch Designer **Accessories:** SNAIL Adhesive, Glue Dots, Medium Whisper White Envelopes, Paper Snips, Tulip Builder Punch, Stampin' Dimensionals

Non-Stampin' Up!: small post-it notes

Measurements:

Pear Pizzazz card base: 4 1/4" x 11", scored and folded at 5 1/2"

Pleased As Punch designer: 4" x 5 1/4" **for envelope flap:** 2 1/4" x 5 3/4"

Flirty Flamingo layer: 4 1/8" x 5 3/8"- need two **Whisper White inside layer:** 3 1/2" x 4 3/4"

Whisper White for tulip: 2" x 3" **Pear Pizzazz for leaves:** scraps

Whisper White 3/8" Metallic Edge Ribbon: about 12"

Stamping tips:

Adhere Pleased As Punch layer to Flirty Flamingo layer with SNAIL. Tie a bow in the middle of the ribbon. Wrap ends around the two layers with the bow slightly on the left side. Adhere to back of layers with SNAIL. Put a glue dot under the bow to secure. Adhere all to card front with SNAIL.



Rock n' Roll technique:

Ink tulip with Flirty Flamingo ink. Stamp once on scrap paper to "stamp-off". Before stamping on white, "rock n' roll" the bottom edge of the tulip on the Flirty Flamingo pad. Stamp on white. Stamp "hello" with black ink. Punch with Tulip Builder Punch. Punch two leaves from Pear Pizzazz with Tulip Builder Punch. Adhere to back of punched tulip with SNAIL. Adhere over the ribbon with dimensionals



.Adhere remaining Flirty Flamingo layer inside card with SNAIL.
Stamp sentiment on white layer with black ink.

To create mask:

Stamp large and smallest tulip on post-it note with one edge of the tulip directly over the area where it is stick on the backside of the note. Cut with scissors. After stamping the tulips on the lower left corner of the inside white layer, cover the tulips with the masks before stamping the leaves. Stamp one side, move the small tulip mask, then stamp the remaining leaves.



Remove the masks to reveal the tulips now look like they are in front of the leaves.



Adhere finished white layer inside card with SNAIL



To add designer paper to the outside of the envelope flap, run a line of SNAIL adhesive around all sides of the top of the flap. Adhere designer paper strip to flap. Trim with Paper Snips, using the edge of the flap as your guide.

Stamp front of envelope to match card as desired.
