Verdant Garden Fun Fold Anniversary



Stamps: Verdant Garden, Beautiful Bouquet

Ink: Pear Pizzazz, Rococo Rose

Cardstock: Whisper White, Rococo Rose, Soft Sea Foam, Verdant Garden Designer

Accessories: SNAIL, Stampin' Dimensionals, Medium Whisper White Envelopes, Subtle 3-D folder, Stitched Label Framelits, Whisper White 3/8" Metallic Edge Ribbon, Glue Dots, Soft Sea Foam Dark Stampin' Blends Alcohol Marker

Measurements:

Soft Sea Foam card base: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2", scored & folded at 2 1/8", 4 1/4"

Rococo Rose front panel: 5 3/8" x 1 7/8" **Soft Sea Foam front panel:** 5 1/4" x 1 3/4"

Whisper White for greeting: 3" x 3 1/2" **Soft Sea Foam layer behind greeting:** 3" x 3 1/2"

Rococo Rose layer behind greeting layers: 3 1/8" x 3 5/8"

Inside white layer: 3 1/2" x 4 3/4" **Inside Rococo Rose :** 3 5/8" x 4 3/4"

Whisper White 3/8" Metallic Edge Ribbon: about 6"

Verdant Garden Designer for envelope flap: 2 1/4" x 5 3/4"

Stamping tips:

Stamp Soft Seafoam front panels with Verdant Garden vines using Pear Pizzazz ink. Emboss both with Subtle 3-D folder. Adhere to Rococo Rose panels with SNAIL. Adhere long panels to card front flap with SNAIL. Adhere greeting panels to card front with dimensionals on just the left side.

Stamp greeting with Rococo Rose ink on white. Cut with Stitched Labels die. Stamp vines around edges of label with stamped-off Pear Pizzazz. Adhere to card front with dimensionals. Color ribbon with Soft Sea Foam Stampin' Blend. Tie in a bow. Adhere to greeting panel with a glue dot.



Stamp inside sentiment on white panel with Rococo Rose ink. Stamp vines with stamped-off Pear Pizzazz ink. Adhere to Rococo Rose panel with SNAIL. Adhere inside card with SNAIL.



To add DSP to the outside of the envelope flap, add a line of SNAIL all around the edges of the flap. Adhere the DSP piece to the flap, lining up the edge of the piece with the top fold of the flap. Press the DSP securely all around the edges, then trim the DSP to match the shape of the flap with scissors.

Stamp front of envelope to match card if desired.
